

Math Unit of Study: We are continuing Chapter 5- Division of Decimals.

Throughout the next few weeks, our math class will be learning about decimal division. We will also be learning how to estimate decimal quotients.

A way to help at home: Ask your child to explain the steps needed to solve a problem and why. Have them show you how to check their answers and ask what other ways a problem could have been solved.
